Your body and imagination


WHAT YOU DO:

8-12 year olds

- 1. Think of 3 words or emotions that can grow such as: big, bigger biggest or happy, happier or SUPA happy (like Dogman).
- 2. You will now make 3 frozen pictures or Tableaus. For example, think of your first emotion or word and how you would display it with your body and face to create your first tableau.
- 3. For the next tableau think about how you could show it with even Bigger or More emotion and expression.
- 4. Finally use all your energy to create the Biggest and Most emotion and expression for your emotion.
- 5. Share your frozen pictures with your friends or family.
