# **Create a CityScape Using Chalk** ••

**Art Form:** Visual Arts • **Other:** Landscape Drawing/Painting

#### **DESCRIPTION:**

Draw various sizes of rectangles to create Skyscrapers with lots of windows.

A **Cityscape** is an artistic representation such as a painting of a city. **Skyscrapers** make up the skyline of the city. **Skyscrapers** historically referred to buildings with between 10 and 20 stories when these types of buildings began tobe constructed in the 1880's. **Stories** is the total number of floors a building has. Today, some skyscrapers in the worldare more than 100 stories.

#### **MATERIALS NEEDED:**

- Chalk in various sizes and colors
- blackconstruction paper, or "Your Sidewalk"

### WHAT YOU DO:

Using a piece of construction paper or vour sidewalk draw avariety of rectangles in various **heights** and widths. You can use as many **colors** as you like to draw each **Skyscraper**. Add windows and doors to each building. If you're making anighttime Cityscape fill in the windows with a variety of **colors**. Don't forget to add in the **moon**. You can add a Sidewalk and **Street** too! See how many **stories** you can make for your Skyscraper.
