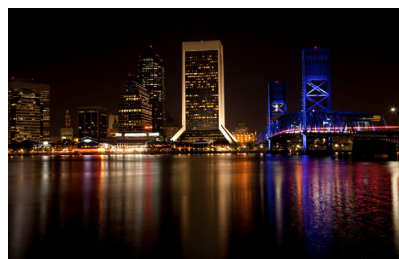


DESCRIPTION:

Draw various sizes of rectangles to create Skyscrapers with lots of windows.

A **Cityscape** is an artistic representation such as a painting of a city. **Skyscrapers** make up the skyline of the city. **Skyscrapers** historically referred to buildings with between 10 and 20 stories when these types of buildings began to be constructed in the 1880's. **Stories** is the total number of floors a building has. Today, some skyscrapers in the world are more than 100 stories.

RECOMMENDED AGE(S):

5-12 years old

TIME TO COMPLETE:

20 - 30 minutes

MATERIALS NEEDED:

- ▶ Chalk in various sizes and colors
- ▶ black construction paper, or "Your Sidewalk"

WHAT YOU DO:

Using a piece of construction paper or your sidewalk draw a variety of **rectangles** in various **heights** and **widths**. You can use as many **colors** as you like to draw each **Skyscraper**. Add windows and doors to each building. If you're making an nighttime **Cityscape** fill in the windows with a variety of **colors**. Don't forget to add in the **moon**. You can add a **Sidewalk** and **Street** too! See how many **stories** you can make for your **Skyscraper**.
